CITY OF MT. WASHINGTON APPLICATION FOR UTILITY SERVICE

The undersigned Applicant of the property listed below, herein called "APPLICANT", hereby makes application to receive utility service(s) from the City of Mt. Washington, herein called "SUPPLIER", under the following conditions:

Water Service

- The Supplier shall provide water service, subject to the limitations hereinafter, provided the connection fee is paid in full by the Applicant and agrees to pay the water rates enacted by ordinance by the Mt. Washington City Council.
 Said connection fee covers the connection charge and impact fee. The Applicant will be responsible for all plumbing installed on said property beginning at the outlet side of the water meter or the Applicant's property line. The installation shall meet the requirements of the Kentucky Department of Health.

 No part of such service line to or within the user's premises may be connected with any source of water other than the Supplier's.
- The Applicant agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of the Supplier's water system and to use the prescribed material and installation prescribed for the portion of the water branch connection provided by the Applicant between the point where the water branch installed by the Supplier ends and any building or other structure located on the premises. The Supplier shall have the final jurisdiction in any question of any service line connecting to its distribution system; it shall determine the allocation of water to users in the event of a water shortage.
- The failure of a user to pay water charges duly imposed shall result in the water being shut off from the user's property. In addition to all other rights and remedies, the Supplier may terminate this agreement and in such event, the user shall not be entitled to receive, nor the Supplier obligated to supply any water under this agreement.
- The Supplier will be responsible for the maintenance of that portion of the service line installed by the Supplier and the Applicant will

 The Applicant grants to the Supplier, any and all easements needed by the Supplier across the property of the Applicant to enable the Supplier to provide water service to the applicant, and the Applicant further grants the Supplier permission or an easement to install a supplier to provide water service to the applicant, and the Applicant further grants the Supplier permission or an easement to install a water line in the roadway in front of or adjacent to the property line or utility easement of the Applicant, with the understanding that the Supplier will be responsible for any damages to the property other than the normal disturbance of the surface of the ground by the installation of service. The City will not be responsible for seeding or sodding of disturbed surfaces.
- The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to collect for the installation of a water meter that requires rock removal, burrowing under pavement and other contingencies for the installation of water service an "ADDITIONAL INSTALLATION FEE", in addition to any other required fee(s).
- "Rock removal", "burrowing under pavement" and "contingencies" are to be defined at the discretion of the Supplier, its agents or
- employees or any other person so designated by the Supplier.

 10. In the event it becomes necessary for the Supplier to shut off the water at a user's property, an additional fee specified by the Supplier

Sewer Service (inside the City limits only)

- The Supplier shall provide sewer service, subject to the limitations hereinafter, provided the connection fee is paid in full by the Applicant and agrees to pay the sewer rates enacted by ordinance by the Mt. Washington City Council.

 Said connection fee covers the connection charge and impact fee. The Applicant shall bring the sewer line to a point located at the
- edge of the property line or easement of the Applicant and shall bear the cost of installing a sewer line from any building or
- improvement on the property to the sewer line or easement.

 The Applicant agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of the Supplier's sewer system and to use the prescribed material and The Applicant agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of the Supplier's sewer system and to use the prescribed material and installation prescribed for the portion of the sewer branch connection provided by the Applicant between the point where the sewer branch installed by the Supplier ends and any building or other structure located on the premises.
- The Supplier will be responsible for the maintenance of that portion of the service line installed by the Supplier and the Applicant will be responsible for the maintenance of that portion installed by the Applicant.
- The Applicant grants to the Supplier, any and all easements needed by the Supplier across the property of the Applicant to enable the Supplier to provide sewer service to the applicant, and the Applicant further grants the Supplier permission or an easement to install a sewer line in the roadway in front of or adjacent to the property line or utility easement of the Applicant, with the understanding that the Supplier will be responsible for any damages to the property other than the normal disturbance of the surface of the ground by the installation of service. The City will not be responsible for seeding or sodding of disturbed surfaces.
