Tuition

FEE TO BE CHARGED

The Board shall charge the fee adopted by the Board, for each student attending its schools whose parent is not a bona fide resident of the District.¹

Unless arrangements are made with the out-of-district's home school district for transfer of Average Daily Attendance revenue, the cost of admission for an out-of-district pupil shall be the sum of four thousand dollars (\$4,000.00) per year.

<u>Unless arrangements are made with the out-of-district's home school district for transfer of Average Daily Attendance revenue, the cost of admission for an out-of-district pupil at the School of Innovation shall be the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) per year.</u>

REDUCTION OF TUITION AND FEES

For families with more than one student, this cost shall be reduced by one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for each additional student down to a minimum of four hundred dollars (\$400.00) per year.

By presenting a copy of the official tax bill, parents/guardians of accepted nonresident students may reduce the assessed amount of tuition by an amount equal to the school taxes paid to the District during the previous year.

PAYMENT

Tuition charges must be paid in advance on a monthly (10 months), semester, or yearly basis.

CHILDREN OF EMPLOYEES

As a professional courtesy, the Board may accept pupils of all full-time school employees without tuition payment regardless of residency. Children of employees must meet the same standards for admission as other non-resident students,
