This agreement with Lakeside Christian Church provides a location where school occupants can relocate in the event that an emergency requires a school to be evacuated. The District seeks to make use of all rooms, restrooms, lobbies, and parking lots for the sole purpose of re-unifying students with their families/guardians in the event of a mass casualty incident, or incident of a similar scope.
