### **OUR OBJECTIVES**

By August 2025, we aim to:

- 1. Increase regional prevention infrastructure supports for 12 NKY districts, measured by the number of NKISP meetings.
- 2. Reduce reports of 30-day vaping among 10th-grade students in project schools by 10%, from 58% to 48% (a 2% decrease each year, as measured by annual KIP surveys).
- 3. Reduce reports of 30-day alcohol use among 10thgrade students in project schools by 5%, from 16% to 11% (a 1% average decrease each year, as measured by annual KIP surveys).

### **OUR VISION**

Develop strategic partnerships in NKY to cultivate drug-free environments and positive mental health cultures and pave the path to healthy achievement throughout life.





### OUR MISSION

To strategically and intentionally prevent substance abuse and drugrelated problems in Northern Kentucky by creating partnerships to increase capacity and infrastructure for our school communities to maintain healthy lifestyles throughout the lifespan.


