HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

An advertisement to accept sealed bids for Sports Medicine and Athletic Trainer Services was posted on the district website on November 5, 2020. Bids were publicly opened December 8, 2020 at 2:00 pm est

FISCAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT:

Monetary contribution, for exclusivity, to the district, middle and high schools in the amount of \$66,000 annually. With a potential total of \$330,000 over the next 5 years pending the mutually agreed upon annual renewals.
