Hybrid and Virtual Instruction



Teachers

- 15 Hybrid Teachers – 71%
- 6 Virtual Teachers – 29%
- Reassigned 3 teachers to new positions before school began to ensure effective social distancing in each classroom.
- All special area, intervention, and special education teachers teach in-person instruction in the hybrid model.
- One teacher works from home 100% of the time due to a medical condition.

Students

- 200 Hybrid Students - 65%
- 107 Virtual Students - 35%

Daily Participation / Attendance

- 94.4% during first semester



Virtual Academic Plan: Core Instruction



Live whole group reading and math lessons each day

Math and reading independent practice

Daily science or social studies lessons

Daily art, music, or physical education lessons

20 minutes of Dreambox (math) and Lexia (reading)



Virtual Academic Plan: Tier II Intervention



Small Group Reading

- 3-4 times a week.
- Individual or in small groups based on their F & P reading level.

Small Group Math

- Frequency depends on student need.
- Teacher schedules small group math time based on student proficiency of the daily target or standard.



Virtual Academic Plan: Tier III Intervention



Added three intervention positions over the summer (school improvement grant)

- RTI Instructional Coach
- Full time reading and math interventionist
- Part-time reading and math interventionist

Provided targeted instruction for any student who needs tier III intervention (hybrid or virtual).

- Detailed schedules to work around student's core and tier II instruction.
- Teachers are doing an extraordinary job scheduling sessions for virtual and hybrid students.



Monitoring Instruction



Professional Learning Communities

- Administration attends all PLC meetings.
- Instructional lesson designs – assessment, standard, learning targets, and strategies/activities.
- Walkthroughs (Hybrid and Virtual Instruction)
 - Administrative team completes walkthroughs and provides teachers with feedback on instruction.
