I. Call to Order

Chairman Joe Ray Thornbury called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm, began with a moment of silence, and led attendees in the Pledge of Allegiance.

III. Student Achievement

A. Student/Staff/Board Recognition

D. Instructional Supervisors' Report

Instructional Supervisor Johnny Belcher expressed sentiments of gratitude for Dr. Mark Myers service as Board Member since Mr. Belcher's first year of teaching and commended Dr. Myers on his being exceptional not only as a PHS athlete, but as a person, professional and Board Member who would be sorely missed.
