If a scholarship recipient decides not to attend a college or university in the year immediately following graduation, or is convicted of any misdemeanor and/or felony offense that is open to the public domain (other than minor traffic offenses), an alternate candidate shall receive the AC Huffman Criminal Justice Scholarship. The AC Huffman Criminal Justice Scholarship Committee reserves the right not to award a scholarship to any applicant if it is determined that a qualified candidate does not exist.

The selection process shall be fair, impartial and consistent. All applicants will receive a letter concluding the selection process.

DUE DATE: Applications must be received in the Counselor's Office by March 31, 2021.

Scholarship Criteria:

- Be a graduating student at Garrard County High School this spring.
- Provide an official copy of a current high school transcript.
- Include proof of acceptance in the form of an admission letter from a college, university or vocational educational center for the academic semester following high school graduation.
- Include ONE Teacher Letter of Recommendation describing your moral character.
- Provide TWO names and telephone numbers of individuals who will serve as your references. These references *should not* include teachers, coaches, counselors, principals, etc.
- Compose a personal statement that outlines why you need this scholarship. Please focus on career goals, personal and/or financial need and all other factors that you wish the Scholarship Committee to know about before selecting a scholarship recipient. <u>Please limit this to no more than one (1) page.</u>
- Include family income on application.
- All applicants must read and sign the enclosed form affirming that all information is true and accurate to their best belief and knowledge.
- Include Essay addressing the prompt.
