<u>Project Coordinator -</u> JOB GOAL: Coordinates the work of the coalition and program activities, including training, communication, data collection, and information dissemination; Develop and implement a variety of programs to heighten awareness, education and prevention of substance abuse.

- Assist in timely data collection, documentation gathering and submission of reports
- Assist Project Director and third party evaluator as needed for required reports, implementation of action plan and to monitor efforts for outcome effectiveness.

- Provide summative report of evaluation of the program to designated personnel
