

Faculty, Staff and Community


Faculty and staff counts and percentages, information on teacher turnover, new teachers, certifications, credentials and qualifications. Also includes community detail on parent involvement.



Assessment Results

Students are assessed in grades 3-8 and 11 in a variety of subjects on tests that were developed by Kentucky teachers. Students in grade 11 also take a college admissions exam. For each subject assessment, students are ranked as either Distinguished, Proficient, Apprentice or Novice. Comparisons may be made between school and district performances based on these performance scores.

State assessment results are limited due to the COVID-19 crisis.

Student participation in advanced level courses, including Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate (IB), Cambridge Advanced International (CAI) and Dual Credit.


Gifted and Talented

Student participation in Primary Talent Pool (K-3) or formally identified for the Gifted and Talented Program (grades 4 - 12).





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Graduation Rate


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Graduation Rate indicators include high school graduation rates, advanced coursework success, dropout and retention.

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
