To Simpson County Schools

STRATEGIC HIGHLIGHTS

In the month of November, Ms. Ji Hui, and I have completed observing every teacher in their classes, met with all principals and administrators in each district. All teachers are adapting and doing well to the unconventional teaching methods this year due to COVID-19. The principals are happy with their teachers, and things seem to be going well.

The next concern is for next academic year is finding over 34 teachers. The Chinese International Education Foundation (CIEF) has moved the responsibility of finding teachers to the partner university in China, which in this case is North China Electric Power University (NCEPU). They are in the process of soliciting for teachers in China and will vet through them to ensure they meet our requirements. In addition, I have submitted an application to CIEF, requesting to hire some local Chinese teacher, and that I will do my own recruiting of the teachers. The proposal was for \$1.25M to hire 34 teachers, in which the organization would pay the teachers directly. A decision has not yet been received but will be received very soon.

FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS

As of November 1^{st,} the balance in the BG Education Management Solution, Inc. account was \$34,400.49, and \$120,000 was received for a total balance of \$154,400.49. During the month of November 2020, a total of \$32,276.77 was spent, with the largest expenses coming from my rent and payments to independent contractors.

OPERATING HIGHLIGHTS

The CI of WKY is increasing its footprint of Chinese language for next year. The institute has reached out to several private schools, independent school districts, and some of the districts the institute has lost. It is projected that the institute is seeking to place a total of 45 teachers for next academic year (21/22).

LOOKING AHEAD

All the Fall 2020 scheduled activities have been cancelled through summer 2021.

Financial Summary

As of November 1, 2020, the balance was \$34,400.49, with a deposit from Simpson County in the amount of \$120,000 for a total of \$154,400.49. Of that amount a total of \$32,276.77 was spent during the month of November 2020 leaving a balance of \$122,123.72 as of November 30, 2020. Due to the uncertainty of receiving additional funds, a frugal approach was taken. Some of the following measures were taken:

- <u>Chinese International Education Foundation (CIEF) Budget</u>— The CI of WKY received a total of \$508,462.00 was received on 07/20/2020.
- **Billings for Confucius Institute Teachers 2020/2021** Billings have been submitted to the school districts, and upon receipt, the total revenue will be \$150,500.00. To date, the institute has received a total of \$77,500.00 from the districts.

Please see below for a snapshot of expenses and projected revenue for November 2020. In addition, the balance sheet, and receipts of all expenditures (including receipts) are included with this report. The balance on the ledger as of November 30, 2020 is \$122,123.72. The funds are not enough to cover the operations for both

November and December; thus, an ACH transfer is requested in the amount of \$0.

Confucius Institute 2020 Executive Board Meeting
