Consider/Approve Updated KCSD In-Person Dashboard

APPLICABLE BOARD POLICY:

01.11 General Powers and Duties

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

The updated KCSD In-Person Dashboard clarifies the length of school closure when a school is >10% in the district testing program. Schools in this category will close all in-person learning for 1 week/9days. Upon return the school will be in the Expanded Hybrid Model/Yellow Category to ensure that everyone is socially distanced. This clarification provides sufficient time for extra cleaning, and staff/students to be separated/away from school while ensuring the school returns during the testing cycle for immediate results the week they return and is socially distanced.

Minimal Community Transmission "On Track" <1 Case/100,000 People Daily In-Person Learning

Increased Community Transmission "Community Spread" >1-10 Cases/100,000 People Daily In-Person Learning or Remote Learning

KCSD District Testing Results

KCSD will implement COVID-19 testing when community data reaches orange level of transmission. Decision matrix will be implemented on a school-by-school basis.

Heightened Community Transmission "Accelerated" >10-25 Cases/100,000 People Daily Hybrid or Remote Learning Only

Substantial Community Transmission "Critical" >25+ Cases/100,000 People Daily Aggressive Hybrid or Remote Learning Only

0-3% All Students who chose in-person learning in school 5 days a week (Socially Distanced or as close to 6 feet as possible)

Expanded Hybrid Model
3.1-8% All Students who chose in-person learning in "hybrid" school A/B rotational model (School level criteria maximizing daily capacity socially distancing at all times)

Aggressive Hybrid Model
8.1-10% All Students who chose in-person learning in "aggressive hybrid" school A/B rotational model (Socially Distanced grades 4-12)

>=10.1% Schools closed to in person learning will be closed for one week/nine days. Schools will return in the expanded hybrid/yellow category and will be tested the week of the return.

Total Number of Positive Cases Reported to KCSD since Mid-August. This total includes students in full-time synchronous and VL.
