# Facilities, Transportation, Safe Schools and Healthy at Work

### **Transportation:**

- Drivers and monitors continue to work with food service delivering food or working in the schools cleaning.
- We provided transportation for employees to vaccinations in Erlanger.
- All buses are up and running. Working with TANK on NHS transportation. TANK is not able to provide transportation for our NHS students dismissing at 2:00 through March 15<sup>th</sup>.

## Facilities:

- Replacement burner for one of the boilers at NIS is scheduled to be in on Wednesday. This is needed to ensure heat in Welcome Center if we move into colder weather.
- Maintenance Dept spread 10 pallets for salt over this last snow session. We have 10 more pallets on hold if needed.
- We had some roof issues at NIS with roof leaks in library and art room. We are waiting on roofing company to inspect but the snow is an issue at this time.

## Safe Schools

- Room numbers have been placed on outside windows as part of our continual security improvements in conjunction with Newport Fire and Police Dept. In addition, floor plans have been placed in fire extinguisher boxes in our schools as part of security improvements.
- ALP Lockdown Shades have provided a quote for all school buildings. Will be working with them to get potential delivery time.
- We are examining the status of door locks throughout the district. We have some additional money that can be utilized for classroom door window coverings and classroom door locks. Greatest need at this point is at NIS. We are looking at 5 new doors at NIS along with 24 new locks.
