Consider/Approve Updated KCSD In-Person Dashboard to adopt CDC indicators and Thresholds for Community Transmission of COVID-19

APPLICABLE BOARD POLICY:

01.11 General Powers and Duties

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

On Tuesday 2/23 the Governor through Executive Order discontinued all school requirements tied to the "color coded COVID-19 Red, Orange, Yellow Zone Counties". KCSD has had an effective model in place for in-person learning that continues to evolve with new information from CDC, DPH, KDE and the Governor's office. Our model has proven to be effective for in-person learning based on data to include feedback. To ensure that our district continues our systemic approach to mitigate risk for our students, staff, families and communities we are recommending adopting the updated CDC Indicators and Thresholds for Community Transmission of COVID-19. The district has previously adopted the testing thresholds from CDC which have been updated in this new version. Our model would not change as we would still implement our testing program when the district is in the orange/red categories. However, this now would be based on the CDC Indicators and Thresholds for Community Transmission. (The Nation's Health Protection Agency) (See Attached CDC Thresholds and New District Dashboard)

Decision matrix will be implemented on a school-by-school basis.

0-4.9% All Students who chose in-person learning in school 5 days a week (Socially Distanced or as close to 6 feet as possible)

Expanded Hybrid Model

5-7.9% All Students who chose in-person learning in "hybrid" school A/B rotational model (School level criteria maximizing daily capacity socially distancing at all times)

Aggressive Hybrid Model
8-9.9% All Students who chose in-person
learning in "aggressive hybrid" school A/B
rotational model (Socially Distanced grades 412)

>=10% Schools closed to in person learning will be closed for one week/nine days. Schools will return in the expanded hybrid/yellow category and will be tested the week of the return.
