We have prepared a scope of work and associated fee based on the request for proposal issued by email on December 19, 2017 on regarding the commissioning scope. A fee breakdown for commissioning is shown at the end of this document.

This project consists of work areas consisting of three phases encompassing approximately 37,250 SF in the base bid, 10,140 SF in Alternate #1, and 7,099 SF in Alternate #2 for a total of 54,375 SF. We used system information from bid package construction drawings and specifications dated January 2, 2018.
