The March 1, 2021 special meeting of the Bullitt County Board of Education was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by Board Chairperson Debby Atherton.

ADOPT THE AGENDA

GENERAL DISCUSSION

In-Person Learning

Superintendent Jesse Bacon explained the plan to increase in-person learning to four days a week for all grade levels based on current trends in positivity rates and completion of staff vaccinations. Safety protocols will continue and seating charts created to help with contact tracing purposes.

The Student Learning Division leadership discussed options to mitigate learning loss during the current school year by offering educational information and entertaining options for students to participate.
