

A JOINT EFFORT FROM KENTUCKY'S EIGHT EDUCATIONAL COOPERATIVES

Dear Superintendent,

Kentucky's eight educational cooperatives are collectively requesting \$8M (\$1M per cooperative, which is **beyond already designated district per pupil funds**) from the Kentucky Department of Education to be distributed over the next two fiscal years (FY21 & FY22) in order to create CRRSA teams at each cooperative in order to assist schools and districts in their efforts to accelerate learning and address social-emotional needs due to school closures and inconsistencies of student participation in remote learning during the COVID-19 pandemic. To release these funds from the KDE ESSER II set-aside to the cooperatives, we have been asked to gain consensus from our 171 public school districts across the Commonwealth.

This regional cooperative plan will allow cooperatives to:

- Hire a CRRSA Coordinator, a Learning Acceleration Specialist, and a Social-Emotional Learning (SEL) specialist to serve
 your districts as you strive to accelerate learning. We will coordinate with schools/districts to help determine specific
 needs, analyze data, and plan services with their coaches and staff.
- Have a regional approach with a statewide impact. We will host joint meetings with our 8 CRSSA directors, Learning Acceleration Specialists, and SEL specialists so that they can share successful strategies around the Commonwealth.
- Obtain national trainers/speakers who can provide their services to all eight cooperatives.
- Begin the hiring process as soon as we gather regional/state consensus so that we can begin to assist with the immediate needs of our districts, including but not limited to summer school efforts in June and July.

This regional cooperative plan will ask districts to:

- Appoint a point of contact ("POC") in your district to coordinate with CRRSA team at the Cooperative level.
- Encourage participation in CRRSA networks and trainings.
- Provide timely feedback to our CRRSA team at the Cooperative level to best meet your district's needs.
