Re: **Instructional Time Adjustment for Elementary Schools for the 2021-2022 School Year**

After consultation with the administrations at the following listed elementary schools, I am requesting approval for the adjustment in the daily instructional time at these elementary schools.

Increasing the instructional day at each of the elementary schools will allow for more instructional time to be provided to the students during the school day. However, each of the elementary schools will continue to be governed by the 2021-2022 School Year Calendar adopted by the Board of Education.
