Consider/Approve Proposal from NaviGate for School Safety & Emergency Preparedness for All Schools Enc.

<u>APPLICABLE BOARD POLICY</u> Capital Construction – 702 KAR 4:160; Fiscal Management 04.32 AP.1

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

Navigate designed and constructed a software system that acts as a clearinghouse for all required school safety and security drills. The system acts as a dashboard for each school and stores the unique safety plan prepared at each school. This platform also incorporates unique safety drills to be utilized by school staff and provides a realistic feel to required drills.

FISCAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT:

The cost for the NaviGate prepared for School Safety & Emergency Preparedness for all schools is \$55,500.00. This is budgeted in the Capital Construction account and will be funded through a future bond sale.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board approve the proposal, in the amount of \$55,500, from NaviGate for a School Safety & Preparedness software program for all schools.
