**FISCAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT:**


The District matching cost for all School Resource Officers is \$292,664. This cost was budgeted and included with the 2018-2019 Tentative Budget approved on May 29, 2018.

**RECOMMENDATION:**


It is recommended that the Board approve the proposed School Resource Officer Coverage for the 2018-2019 School Year in the amount of \$292,664.00.
