Consider/Approve: the Building Operations Support Allocation Staffing Levels for the 2018-2019 School Year.

APPLICABLE BOARD POLICY:

05.2 Maintenance

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

Each year District Staff calculate the Building Operations Staffing coverage based upon the State Calculation Formula. The State formula considers certified staffing levels, student enrollment, and square footage for each school location to arrive at the recommended coverage. The recommended increase in coverage as per the enclosed schedule reflects the increase in square footage due to new constructions as well as a change to move the cafeteria cleaning responsibilities away from Food Service and increase the indirect cost rate charged to Food Service to cover the cost. This change will allow District Staff to better control staffing levels and manage training for appropriate cleaning requirements.

FISCAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT:

The revised Support Operations Staffing calculations provides an overall increase of 3.50 staff members. The actual cost implications will be determined when staff members are hired and consideration is given to their actual years of experience. There is an offset for some cost increase once the indirect cost rate is calculated. This cost is included in the Tentative Budget approved on May 29, 2018.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board approve the Building Operations Support Allocation for the 2018-2019 School Year.
