#### **HISTORY/BACKGROUND:**

The Kenton County School District recognizes that digital media, including the Internet, provides access to a wealth of instructional resources. In certain circumstances, instructional needs may warrant the use of KCSD technology at home, including but not limited to, Windows laptops, Chromebooks, and iPads. The Device Home Use Agreement sets parameters for the use of these devices thus providing technological access to children who might not otherwise be able to utilize technology outside of school premises/hours.
