## Resolution:

The Board of Education has received a request for approval of out-of-state travel in June for students to attend the National Beta Club Convention in Orlando Florida. In light of the long-term educational, social, and civic benefit of students participating in this nature of activity, by adopting this resolution, the Board of Education approves this trip subject to the following conditions relating to the ongoing public health emergency caused by the COVID-19 pandemic:

- 1) The cost of participant registration in the event will be paid by the School/Club.
- 2) Adult students and the parent of minor students must sign an acknowledgement and release form provided by the School District.
- 3) Transportation will not be provided by, arranged by, or funded by the School District. Adult students and the parents of minor students must arrange for travel to and from Orlando, which may include families of multiple participating students cooperating with each other to arrange for travel.
- 4) Lodging in Orlando is the responsibility of the adult student or the parents of minor students. To the extent Club funds are available through fundraising efforts, participants will be equitably reimbursed for lodging expenses. Participants and their families may cooperate with each other to arrange for shared housing accommodations.
- 5) Each minor student must be accompanied at all times on the trip by their own parent, or by the parent of another participating student who agrees to fulfill this role throughout the trip, including for travel and lodging. Adult students may not serve in this role on behalf of minor students.
- 6) For any unstructured or unscheduled time during the trip, each minor student must remain under the supervision of his/her designated parent chaperone and must comply with any rules established by the trip sponsors and/or chaperones regarding check-in times and maintenance of contact throughout the trip.
- 7) At all times during travel, during the convention, and upon the students' return from the trip, students are representing the Marion County Public Schools and are expected to be good ambassadors for the School District, including complying with the District's policies and student code of conduct and complying with applicable rules or requirements established by the convention and lodging facilities, recreational venues, and by public health authorities relating to sanitizing, social distancing, masking, and, related provisions.
- 8) If any participant or participant's parent becomes symptomatic for COVID-19 during the trip, or tests positive for COVID-19 during the trip, all persons who are traveling in the same vehicle or lodged in the same room with that individual will comply with any isolation or quarantine orders imposed by public health officials in Orlando and the affected student/family will be responsible for any special travel arrangements which might be necessary relating to the return to Kentucky.
