- Return to full-time instruction ~ We are excited to announce that 96.2% of our LES students have returned back to full-day in-person instruction. Students and staff are so excited to be back engaging in full days of learning. Many positive comments have also been shared by parents.
- Our 21st Century Afterschool Program will begin back for an in-person program on Monday, March 22, 2021. Students who sign-up for this wonderful program will be engaged in an hour of Homework Help provided by Lincoln teachers and an hour plus of enrichment activities provided by the 21st Century staff. The program will run daily from 3 – 5:30 pm.
- BIG plans for summer learning at Lincoln have begun. We plan to do an eight-week academic and enrichment camp collaboration with our 21st Century Learning Program. Several LES teachers and staff have already signed on to offer their services in making this offering possible for our little devils. (June 7 July 30)
- Scholastic Book Fair ~ Our gifted Scripps Howard/WCPO Book Fair was a huge success with over 2,425 brand new books being selected by our students from preschool through sixth grade. We are so incredibly grateful for this generous literacy gift.
- NWEA MAP Testing We will begin administering the spring MAP test to our students K 6th grades the week of April 19th. The students will test in the areas of Math, Reading and Language.
