



The proposed 2021 graduation schedules provide that no graduation will be conducted prior to the last student day.

All ceremonies will be held at a JCPS school or facility with controlled entrance, limited capacity and will follow all current Health Department and Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) health and safety guidelines, including mask wearing and social distancing.



Graduation 2021

- Schools will hold ceremonies on their football fields.
- Schools which do not have stadiums (Brown, Liberty, Phoenix, Georgia Chaffee Teenage Parent Program, and Jefferson County High School) will use the football facilities at other high schools.
- The Graduating Class for each school will be divided into groups appropriate to meet the current Health Department/KDE guidelines and stadium capacity.
- Schools may have between one and five ceremonies, depending on the number of groups of graduates in the class.
- Each graduate will receive an allotted number of admission tickets to distribute to family members. The total number of tickets will be based upon the current Health Department/KDE guidelines for outside stadium bleacherstyle seating.

Graduation 2021

- Ceremonies will be conducted on Thursday, May 27 at 5:30 p.m. and 7:30 p.m.; and on Friday, May 28 at 9 a.m., 11 a.m., 2 p.m., 4 p.m., and 6 p.m.; and Saturday, May 29 at 10 a.m. and 12 noon. Each individual school will decide which times they will utilize.
- If inclement weather occurs, ceremonies will move to June 1.
- School Board members will decide the session(s) they will attend at each of their schools.
- Each school will decide how to include the Class of 2020 in their celebrations.
