Facilities, Transportation, Safe Schools and Healthy at Work

Transportation:

- Two drivers are considering driving for Summer School. We will also need to employ two monitors as well.
- All buses are up and running. TANK is now running both morning and afternoon routes for NHS.
- Working on procedures for staff wanting to drive district vehicles. Have asked other districts and the state for their procedures and additional guidance.
- We are getting bids on resurfacing our bus lot and investigating if we can remove the berm to allow us additional room to park our vehicles.

Facilities:

- Replacement burner for the boiler at NIS has been installed.
- Maintenance Dept did formal walkthroughs at each building. We are trying to be more preventive in our approach to each of the buildings. This approach provided us with some additional work orders we needed to address.
- Roof issues at NIS in library and art room are going to be patched to prevent any further damage.
- We are looking to remove the steps entering the side door into the Welcome Center and replace them with concrete.

Safe Schools

- State compliance officer did site visits at all schools. We have some issues we are working on related to his site visit. The major issues are related to entrance from the Welcome Center into NIS. We are going to need to fob all of the double doors in the Welcome Center, eliminate some push bars on some doors, and fob some additional doors as we move forward. We are currently working with Silco to get quotes on these items.
- Some door locks at NIS are going to be replaced due to normal wear and tear. This will cost us approximately \$11K.
- ALP Lockdown Shades have been installed in all buildings. State compliance officer was very impressed with the shades. Asked me to provide information to other surrounding districts after he found out the limited amount of money utilized to cover our classroom doors.
- Tech dept is going to cut out the numbers for the outside doors to finalize our project with the Newport Fire Dept.

Healthy at Work

- We are still working on our COVID planning as we move forward with the new guidance provided by CDC concerning spacing in classrooms.
