- 1. As of March 19, 2021 -65% of student w/special needs receive in-person instruction.
- 2. Submitted 2020-21 KY Registry Report for students identified with Visual Impairments. Newport serves three students in this category/classification. The three students attend on-campus/in-person. Kate Neikirk, Certified Teacher of the Visually Impaired provides special designed instruction in co-taught educational settings. Katie Toennis, Orientation & Mobility provides related services (navigating skills in the community and school environments). Specialized technology (large screen laptops, magnifiers, specialized software/apps.) support student learning and accessibility.
