HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

The Preschool Partnership Grant will support collaboration between the district and early child care partners to increase the quality of care provided to preschool age, at risk residents of the district. 4C for Children will be contracted to work with the care centers and the preschool staff training in literacy, numeracy and social emotional. Focusing on the lowest areas of the district for Kindergarten Readiness, this training will provide best practice for staff to increase quality, in turn increasing Kindergarten Readiness.

Kenton County School District Preschool Partnership Grant Proposal 4C for Children Services November 2018 through May 2020

Purpose:

Kenton County School District in partnership with local community partners, including 4C for children, has identified a need to assist Kenton County child care providers in supporting developmentally appropriate curriculum, with a focus on early numeracy and early literacy activities, delivered through best practices for children in preschool classrooms and child care settings. 4C will provide specific training and individualized coaching for Kenton County child care providers targeting areas based on lowest kindergarten readiness scores.

Outcomes:

Specific measures of success will be determined by lead staff from Kenton County School District with support of the Preschool Partnership coalition collecting the data to report to the Kentucky Department of Education. 4C will monitor progress towards these outcomes in evaluations, action plans, and surveys.

- Knowledge gained via training
- Achievement of identified goals for each classroom and/or teacher
- Provider feedback surveys to assess satisfaction and knowledge acquisition

Services Provided:

1. Social and Emotional Training (An extension training session)

Description: This will serve as a continuation of the momentum started in the 2017-2018 school year Conscious Discipline training series. Participants will be given the opportunity to put knowledge, strategies, and tools into action through intentional implementation tactics to enhance opportunities for social and emotional development in the classroom.
