Consider/approve the purchase for the online platform Xello for students to create successful futures through exploration and planning for their Individual Learning Plan (ILP).

APPLICABLE BOARD POLICY:

01.1 Legal Status of the Board; 04.31 Authority to Encumber and Expend Funds

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

The Kentucky Department of Education no longer provides Career Cruising, an online platform for students to create their ILP. Kenton County Schools researched and selected the online platform Xello to replace Career Cruising to meet the needs of students for their ILP.

FISCAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT:

The annual cost for middle and high school is \$3.50 per student. In addition, onsite training cost is \$3500. The request is for the school board to fund the onsite training and half of the per student cost. The middle schools and high schools will fund the other half of the per student cost. See attachment for details.

RECOMMENDATION:

Recommend the purchase for the online platform Xello for students to create successful futures through exploration and planning for their Individual Learning Plan (ILP). This purchase would be for one year 1/1/19 through 12/31/19 with the option for renewal.
