AGENDA ITEM (ACTION ITEM):

Consider/Approve employing emergency certified substitute teachers for the 2021-22 school year.

APPLICABLE BOARD POLICY:

03.4 Substitute Teachers

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

The Kentucky Department of Education requires the District to obtain Board approval on an annual basis to utilize emergency certified substitute teachers by presenting the following statement for approval: "The Board of Education authorizes the Superintendent to employ teachers or substitute teachers with emergency or adjunct instructor certification when no qualified teachers have applied for vacant positions". The District follows the Education Professional Standards Board (EPSB) requirement when hiring emergency certified substitute teachers to possess a minimum of 64-college credits with a minimum GPA of 2.5. Of KCSD's 278 substitute teachers, 128 are employed on an emergency certified basis. Continuing the ability to employ emergency certified substitutes is necessary as the supply of substitute teacher applicants holding a teaching certificate does not meet the demand of the District.

FISCAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT:

No additional cost to KCSD. Emergency certified substitutes earn \$14 less per day than fully certified substitutes.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approval to employ emergency certified substitute teachers for the 2021-22 school year.


