C. Provide a complete narrative of the proposed project.

3. Minor project not listed on Facility Plan:

The scope of work at Scott High School involves the complete renovation of all mechanical systems, lighting systems, plumbing systems, building finishes, security systems, fire protection, ceiling systems associated with the auditorium; gymnasium; and remaining classrooms. The project also includes the construction of a new practice gym to be built adjacent to the existing gymnasium. The existing gymnasium renovations shall include the installation of a new scoreboard, scoreboard equipment, sound system, bleachers, and gym floor. The last phase of construction also includes the demolition of the existing natatorium and the construction of a new pool facility. The new pool facility will also include new locker rooms, spectator bleachers, scoreboard equipment, and sound equipment. The balance of the main front office will be completed along with the gym lobby, restrooms, and concession stand.

This phase of construction at Scott High School reflects all remaining site work to include the replacement of the original (4) tennis courts with a new facility. The current tennis courts are impacted by the design of the remaining parking and site circulation changes. The existing baseball field renovations include new dugouts, bleachers, scoreboard, sound system, field irrigation system, and press box/concession stand upgrades. The entire site will be regraded for new and expanded parking, site circulation changes, site lighting, site security camera system, pedestrian connectivity, and site signage.

The remaining scope of work at Woodland Middle School involves the replacement of all remaining HVAC systems not previously upgraded with recent phases of construction. The proposed renovation work at Woodland also involves flooring replacement, ceiling replacement, door replacement, and painting not accomplished with previous work. The proposed scope of work also involves security upgrades identified by the State Security Marshal not included with the recent safety and security upgrades. Replace gymnasium bleachers, sound system, and scoreboard. Renovations to the existing football field involve grading, water service, electric service, and installation of water irrigation.

This proposed construction application also involves major site improvements to the Taylor Mill Elementary School Site. The recently purchased municipal water tower will be demolished and the property owned by the School District will be graded for new expanded parking and site circulation changes. Any excavated cut from this site will be spoiled with the final grading changes taking place at Scott High School. The site improvements include new pedestrian connectivity, site lighting, site security, signage, site drainage system, and asphalt replacement.
