RE: Last instructional day for 2020-2021

In accordance with Kentucky Revised Statute, Kentucky Administrative Regulations, Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) requirements, and Board Policy, let it be known that Thursday, May 27, 2021, can be utilized as the last instructional day for students. This date represents Boone County Schools' adherence towards meeting the mandated hours of instruction and the mandated number of instructional days as outlined by state statute and the Kentucky Department of Education.

By adjusting May 18, 2021, which was originally set as an X* Day in case of the need for a May Primary Election, to a Student Instructional Day, then May 27, 2021:

- Represents Student Instructional Day number 172
- Equates to 1075 Student Instructional Hours

Also, by making this adjustment, May 28, 2021 can be utilized as the district's Closing Day for teachers fulfilling the contractual obligation of 187 Teacher Days.
