A MUNICIPAL ORDER APPROVING THE COMMUNITY CATALYST GRANT PROGRAMS TARGETED FOR THE NORTHWEST NEIGHBORHOOD REVITATLIZATION STRATEGY AREA.

WHEREAS, at an Owensboro Board of Commissioners meeting conducted on March 16, 2021, the Community Catalyst Grant Programs targeted for the Northwest Neighborhood Revitalization Strategy Area were presented and discussed; and

WHEREAS, the Owensboro Board of Commissioners supports the local funding of the Community Catalyst Grant Programs through the annual budget process in order to continue to address the need for housing, economic and community development in the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE CITY OF OWENSBORO, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Community Catalyst Grant Programs will be funded through local funding and focused within the boundaries of the Northwest Neighborhood Revitalization Strategy Area to address housing, economic and community development through a Single Family Rental Rehabilitation Reimbursement Program, Single Family New Development Program, Single Family Rehabilitation Program, a 50/50 (fifty/fifty) Demolition Grant and beautification projects.
