Covid-19 Guidance: Food Concession Stand Guidance

- CDC continues to recommend that all people wear face coverings in public and when around people who do not live in the same household. All concession stand workers are REQUIRED to wear a face mask at all times.
- Communicate to all volunteers that they should not help if they are sick, have any symptoms of Covid-19 or have been in contact with someone who has Covid-19.
- Keep the number of volunteers to a minimum and exercise physical distancing between workers as much as possible.
- Close concession stands immediately if someone develops symptoms while working.
- Consider the use of fans or open windows to improve air circulation.
- Post signage at stand for patrons to maintain social distancing of 6 feet.
- Ensure the concession stand is adequately stocked with soap, paper towels, hand sanitizer and supplies for cleaning, sanitizing and disinfecting.
- Gloves are **required** at all times for all concession stand workers.
- Discontinue self-service of food, drinks, condiments, utensils, etc. No shared items for customers.
- Use tongs, utensils or deli-sheets, in addition to wearing gloves, to assist in avoiding touching any food items.
- All food items need to be individually wrapped or dispensed in a designated container.
- All food items needing to be cooked must be prepared on site and individually wrapped.
 Only baked goods prepared at home and individually wrapped may be brought in to be sold.
- Have workers put condiments on foods, such as hot dogs, sandwiches etc, instead of providing condiment dispensers for customers.
- Routinely clean and disinfect high touch surfaces. This includes door handles, shared equipment, cash registers, etc.
