Meeting called to order at 4:02 PM by Mr. Meyers

Opening Business

- a. Approval of the Agenda
 - Motion made by Ms. Goetz, second made by Ms. Buschle. No objections.
- b. Approval of the February Minutes
 - Motion made by Mr. Campbell, second made by Ms. Buschle. No objections.
- c. Good News Report
 - Mr. Meyers reminded council that he wanted to keep the focus on student achievement. The junior class ACT was held on March 9th in the gymnasium.
 - CASE testing will be beginning this week for middle school students.
 - KPREP testing will be held during the last 14 days of the school year.
- d. Public Comment
 - No members of the public present for public comment.

Student Achievement

- a. Assessing Student Achievement
 - a. Academic Readiness Benchmarks and Career Readiness Benchmarks
 - 54 seniors will currently count toward our CCR percentage. Only students with a graduation code in Infinite Campus count toward CCR percentage.
 - 30% of seniors are current College and/or Career Ready
 - 11 students are College Ready
 - 5 students are College and Career Ready
 - Mr. Meyers broke down the potential students becoming College and/or Career Ready.

School Improvement Planning

- a. Progress Monitoring-Mr. Meyers shared that next year's CSIP is in its absolute most early stages at this point.

Budget Report

- a. SBDM reviewed the budget report.
- b. Mr. Meyers brought up that there will be a prom this year, outside at Gil Lynn Park. The school is renting tents and having a catered meal for the event. Mr. Meyers proposed that SBDM could use senior trip funds that are not currently in the plan to be used towards this event. Mr. Campbell stated that he is in favor of reallocating the funds, especially since this year's seniors didn't get a prom last year. Ms. Goetz agreed. Mr. Meyers discussed the meeting that he had about prom with the seniors last week. All members agreed that the senior trip money should be re-allocated towards this. Ms.

Goetz proposed that senior trip and field trip money be re-allocated towards prom. Mr. Campbell seconded. No objections.

Committee Reports

a. Science and Social Studies Professional Learning Committee Reports

-Mr. Laufmann presented on behalf of the science department. He discussed strategies and interventions the department is attempting to help with student achievement.

- Mr. Campbell presented on behalf of the social studies department. He discussed strategies and interventions the department is attempting to help with student achievement. The Civics test was administered to students three weeks ago, 93% of students passed and the other 7% of students will have multiple opportunities to pass. The department has been having success with Vocabulary.com, ranking Dayton High School 12th in the state of Kentucky. The department has been working on writing their standards and are near completion of the vertical standards. Mr. Campbell inquired about the potential to order a class set of Google Cardboard and discussed the possibility of using Google Expeditions.

-32.4 certified positions were allocated for last year and 32.4 have been certified for this year. Discussion around a potential in-person foreign language teacher. Discussion around the allocations for instructional aide for the former DaytonA and nurse.
