

GAP CDIP GOAL

By the year 2022, Lincoln Elementary School will increase the gap rate of students with disabilities from 30% to 50%, and Dayton Middle School will increase the gap rate for students with disabilities from 44.9 to 54.9.

GAP CDIP OBJECTIVE

Collaborate to increase the gap rate of students with disabilities from 30% to 40% at Lincoln Elementary School and from 44.9 to 55 at Dayton Middle School.

GAP UPDATE

85% of our students are on Free/Reduced Lunch, therefore, we have an inverted GAP meaning the majority of our students fall into the GAP category. Because of that, our GAP scores increase and/or decrease as our Proficiency scores increase and/or decrease.
