BASIC FUNCTION:

To provide leadership and support in consistent, high quality instruction and student achievement throughout the school.

- · Collaborates with teachers and administration to identify best practices for individual and small groups of students
- ·Participates in meetings and activities with teachers, administration, and families to discuss strategies, goals, student needs, and student progress
- · Identifies and uses evidence-based, high quality instructional materials
- · Attends training sessions and meetings to improve knowledge and skills
