

## LDC & Todd County School District Proposal for 2021- 2022 School Year

## Summary

To build equity of access to rigorous, standards-driven writing in response to disciplinary reading assignments across all classrooms, Todd County School District seeks to increase coherence across the instructional systems of curriculum, assessment, and educator professional learning. To that end, the District seeks to support teachers in the enactment of data inquiry cycles using LDC modules from the REAL WORKS anchor curriculum. Additionally, the district seeks to enable its instructional leaders to focus on improving the quality and consistency of teaching and student learning by delivering standards-driven and literacy-rich instruction to every student in every classroom.

This proposal presents the products, services, and implementation steps for addressing the District's needs during the 2021-2022 school year. Together, these elements build a foundation for deeper learning within and across an increasing number of classrooms each school year.
