Board Agenda Item: (painting mural)

I am requesting that Lebanon Junction Elementary be granted permission from the board to paint a mural in an office area. The Counselor's outer office is a small space that used to be used for small groups and sensory objects, however, with increasing behaviors, this space is often used by special education staff to separate students from peers when they are escalated. As a result, all items had to be removed as they became objects to be destroyed or thrown by students during escalation prior to being retrained. Now, this outer office area is an empty white space. We would like to have our ART teacher paint a mural on these walls that depicts strategies for self-regulation and de-escalation. This would not only provide students with a visual reminder of the strategies they are taught by their teacher, but also ensure that this room is not viewed by students or adults as a "holding room" and maintains an instructional purpose. We are only asking to paint the walls of the room, and are not seeking to make structural changes, so this area could easily be painted or covered in the future.
