1. James E. Biggs Annual Update

Ms. Elizabeth Miller, Principal provided the Board James E. Biggs' annual update. PLCs were held virtually or in-person during the year. Certified PLCs meet every other week and Classified PLCs meet monthly. PLCs focus on skills monitoring. The school's Wildly Important Goal (WIG) for 2020-2021 is teaching the students to recite the alphabet to help with the Kindergarten Brigance screening. Teacher Retention is consistent with no new hires during this year. The Annual Family Survey reports that 100% of the families are satisfied with James E. Biggs Preschool. Professional Development focused on monthly google meetings with the District Technology Integration Specialist. Curriculum reflection on literacy components, new preschool standards and assessment review.

3. Spring Surplus Award

In April of 2021, the spring surplus items were recognized and advertised to all staff through email and the CIPS website. Four bidders participated and the items awarded as indicated. Total bid award to be collected is \$2,646.00. This will be brought back to the Board requesting approval at the May 27, 2021 Regular meeting.

4. SB128 Supplemental Year Applications

The Supplemental School Year Program was created March 24 when Gov. Andy Beshear signed into legislation Senate Bill 128, which gives students the option to repeat the 2020-2021 school year due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Students had until May 1 to decide whether they want to retake the 2020-2021 school year or supplement courses they have already taken. By statute, school boards are not allowed to make decisions on an individual basis. School boards have until June 1 to decide whether to accept all or none of the requests. There are a total of fourteen applications received since May 1, 2021. This item will be brought back to the Board requesting approval at the May 27, 2021 Regular meeting.
