DHS Current Grad Rate – We started the year at 96% as we have 2 students on Alternate assessment. Senior Grades are due on Friday, May 21st – we will have our May tabulation of Grad Rate at that time – there could potentially be a student who completes in June that gives us our final Grad Rate.

DHS Current College and Career Readiness Rate – We are now at 31/53 students who are CCR, which is 58.4%. We have 1 or 2 more students who could reach CCR and push our final number above 60%.

All 9 of our ATC seniors met Career Readiness benchmarks. All other students completed the appropriate Industry Certifications attached to the Career Pathway they are in.
