#### **AGENDA ITEM (ACTION ITEM):**

Consider/Approve 2022 Certified, Classified, Substitute & Supplemental Salary Schedules

#### **APPLICABLE BOARD POLICY:**

03.121 and 03.221 Salaries

#### **HISTORY/BACKGROUND:**

All salaries for certified personnel shall be based on a single salary schedule providing, at minimum, for the number of working days required by law. Management and KCEA have agreed to a specific pay increase for the 2022 187 Day Certified Salary Schedule. The certified salary schedule increase from 2021 is approximately 1.5%.

The Substitute Salary Schedule remains the same as 2021 and the Supplemental Position Schedule includes only a change to the number of Exceptional Children lead teacher positions. The Miscellaneous Position Schedule includes an increase of the Home Hospital Teacher Substitute rate and addition of school Event Worker and Cooperating teacher rates.

The Classified Salary Schedule reflects a schedule increase of 1.5% for all positions
