A. Senate Bill 128

Superintendent David Trimble recommended the Board approve Senate Bill 128 and accept all students. Mr. Trimble cited a parent's right to this legislated option and Guidance Counselor Dawn Stewart's ability to assist in implementation as reasons for his recommendation.

A. Senate Bill 128 (continued)

Superintendent Trimble explained that caution would be exercised with informational sessions offered to help parents make appropriate decisions.

B. 2021-2022 School Calendar - Second Reading

Superintendent David Trimble presented for a second reading the 2021-2022 School Calendar with no changes as presented previously in April.

C. 2021-2022 Tentative Budget

District Finance Officer Denise Clark shared details regarding the 2021-22 Tentative Budget with only slight adjustments made from the Draft Budget reviewed in January that now includes salary changes and the 1% pay increase to full time employees. Mrs. Clark further shared that typically a tentative SEEK estimate for the next school year is made available to school districts in time to include, but due to the effects of the pandemic this has been delayed causing a more conservative approach to budgeting.
