- Summer School Numbers
 - Middle School – 32 students started on June 7th
 - High School – 46 students started on June 7th
 - Number of Students Who Have Completed Requirements as of 6/18 –
 - Middle School – 19
 - High School - 15, several have completed one or more courses, but still have a few to go.
 - **High School Credits Earned:**
 - 24 credits through completion of missing assignments
 - 15 credits through Edmentum
 - 39 Total Credits Earned for High School students in summer school as of 6/18.
- Summer Enrichment – We are using IXL for grades 7-12 (Reading) and grades 10-12 (Math). We are using Success Maker in Grades 7-9 (Math).



DHS Current Grad Rate – We started the year at 96% as we have 2 students on Alternate assessment. We finished the year with a 96% graduation rate, 52/54 – graduating all students enrolled as seniors in the class of 2021.

DHS Current College and Career Readiness Rate – Our final CCR for the year was 62%, or 31/50.

Athletics:

Softball – qualified for the regional tournament and was district runner-up. Beat NCC to advance to the district championship game and qualify for regional tournament.

Track – Nolan Brooks finished 3rd overall in the Pole Vault at State Championships. Track team qualified and competed at the State Track Championships.
