  - Middle School 32 students started on June 7th
  - High School 46 students started on June 7th

      - High School 15, several have completed one or more courses, but still have a few to go.

    - o 24 credits through completion of missing assignments
    - o 15 credits through Edmentum

**DHS Current Grad Rate** – We started the year at 96% as we have 2 students on Alternate assessment. We finished the year with a 96% graduation rate, 52/54 – graduating all students enrolled as seniors in the class of 2021.

**DHS Current College and Career Readiness Rate** – Our final CCR for the year was 62%, or 31/50.

**Softball** – qualified for the regional tournament and was district runner-up. Beat NCC to advance to the district championship game and qualify for regional tournament.

**Track** – Nolan Brooks finished 3<sup>rd</sup> overall in the Pole Vault at State Championships. Track team qualified and competed at the State Track Championships.
