June Curriculum Department Highlights

District Retreat

The Curriculum team has been planning and preparing for the district leadership retreat. During this time, district and school leaders will continue setting the stage for our district focus areas (PLCs, intervention, behavior intervention system, culturally responsive teaching, and high expectations) during the 2021-2022 school year.

District Curriculum Work

In order to ensure a viable and guaranteed district curriculum, a district-wide team consisting of principals, instructional coaches, plc leads, district leaders, and outside experts has been created to begin this process. This work will launch in July and continue throughout the 21-22 school year. The team will focus on reading/writing and math curriculum development and alignment for the 21-22 school year.

"Camp Wildcat" Summer Learning

We have completed two weeks of summer learning here in Newport, each school has been focused on closing learning gaps due to the pandemic. Students participating in Camp Wildcat will be assessed weekly on standards taught. Student data will be analyzed and communicated with students and parents. Weekly progress reports will be sent home. Our post-assessment for Camp Wildcat will be administered on June 30th. Data collected from this assessment will be analyzed to determine student mastery of standards taught during our summer learning sessions.
