Project Details	
Project Description The Instant Language Assistant (ILA) Software & Hardware allows any two people to instantly have a live real-time translated conversation no matter language, disability, device, or location. A pilot at Boone KY Schools would involve TranslateLive (TL) providing 2 (two) free ILA Pro Device and the ILA Service licenses for one-to-one communication (Interaction Code) for 60-days. TL would first complete all required security reviews to ensure compliance with IT requirements. Upon approval, TL would provide training to the staff and get feedback via video conferencing calls. During the pilot, Boone KY Schools would be provided an ILA Pro to use where they see fit to test the usefulness of the product. The software could also be loaded pre-setup with commonly used phrases or processes for even faster and accurate interactions if provided by Boone KY Schools. If the pilot is successful, TL would work with Boone KY Schools on the production pricing. Each unit that can be connected to a guest is called a HOST. Any second device that connects to a Host would not need a license. The production cost for an ILA Pro device is \$839, and the software HOST license is \$30 a month for unlimited AI usage in one-to-one communication. However, the licensing price could be greatly reduced based on volume.
