- Middle School 32 students started on June 7th
- High School 46 students started on June 7th
 - o Number of Students Who Have Completed Requirements as of 7/19
 - Middle School 2 middle school students are currently working at school to complete assignments/credits. We have a few students also working from home. We have 27 out of 32 middle school students who started summer school that have completed all work.
 - High School 19 students have completed all credits.
 - High School We have 27 out of 46 students have completed all credits.
- High School Credits Earned:
 - o 24 credits through completion of missing assignments
 - o 30.5 credits through Edmentum
 - o 54.5 Total Credits Earned for High School students in summer school as of 7/19.
- Summer Enrichment We are using IXL for grades 7-12 (Reading) and grades 10-12 (Math). We are using Success Maker in Grades 7-9 (Math).
 - o Between June 7 and July 19, we have a combined 20 students that have spent 42 hours and 33 minutes answering 11,468 ELA questions on IXL.
 - Those 20 students have also spent 44 hours and 36 minutes answering 5,755 math questions on IXL.
