❖ Summer at Lincoln ~ We are winding down our summer programing this last week of July. We are proud of the effort we put into the different eight-week learning opportunities that were put into place and even more proud of the students and families who took full advantage.

SUMMER RECAP:

- 1. Summer Enrichment Program ~
 - This opportunity was geared to ALL current LES students in grades K 5.
 Students who signed-up kept their learning devices over the summer to participate in Lexia (Reading) and SuccessMaker (Math) during the summer months. We originally had 123 students sign up for this and 38 students have actively participated in the program. Two LES staff members have made weekly encouragement calls for all students to participate.
- 2. Summer Learning Program ~
 - This was an 8-week academic program that targeted students in grades
 K 7 who were performing below grade level in either math or reading
 or both. Specific interventions were utilized with students. We
 originally have had 121 students participate in this programing during
 the summer.
- 3. 21st Century Summer Program ~
 - This traditionally 5-week program transitioned into an 8-week program so that it could simultaneously run with our summer learning program. There were 69 students who have participated in this program this summer.
