

July 26, 2021 SBDM Meeting

In attendance: Scott Meyers, Jennifer Sparks, Angela Gonzalez, Brad Campbell, Erin Goetz, Angela Buschle, Christopher Wright, Rick Wolf

Meeting called to order at 4:03 PM by Chairperson Meyers.

1. Opening Business

- a. Approval of the Agenda-Motion to amend the agenda to reflect the working schedule discussion. Motion made by Mr. Campbell, second by Ms. Buschle. No objections.
- b. Approval of the June Minutes-Motion to approve the minutes by Mr. Campbell, second by Ms. Goetz. No objections.
- c. Good News Report-Mr. Meyers reported that hiring is hopefully finished. Summer school is wrapping up this week.
- d. Public Comment-No public in attendance to comment.

2. Student Achievement Report/Data

- a. Assessing Student Achievement
  - i. Middle School-32 students began summer school on June 7<sup>th</sup>.
  - ii. High School-46 students began summer school on June 7<sup>th</sup>.
  - iii. Middle School-2 middle school students are currently working at school to complete assignments/credits. We have a few students also working from home. We have 27 out of 32 middle school students who started summer school that have completed all work.
- b. High School Credits Earned
  - i. 24 credits earned through completion of missing assignments.
  - ii. 30.5 credits earned through Edmentum.
  - iii. 54.5 total credits earned for high school students in summer school as of 7/19.
- c. Summer Enrichment
  - i. We are using IXL for grades 7-12 for reading and grades 10-12 math. We are using success maker in grades 7-9 for math.
    1. Between June 7<sup>th</sup> and July 19<sup>th</sup>, we have a combined 20 students that have spent 42 hours and 33 minutes answering 11,468 ELA questions.
    2. Those 20 students have also spent 44 hours and 36 minutes answering 5,755 math questions.

3. School Improvement Planning

- a. Mr. Wolf gave a report on the school improvement plan diagnostic report.

4. Budget Report

- a. Mr. Meyers presented the budget report to council. He discussed a desire to eliminate class supply lists next summer and to spend SBDM or ESSR funds to

buy school supplies. Ms. Gonzalez motioned to move surplus copy paper money towards school supplies. Second by Ms. Sparks. No objections.

5. Bylaw or Policy Review

- a. Second reading of SBDM policy 9.03: Emergency Management Plan. Motion made to accept the policy by Ms. Buschle, second by Ms. Goetz. No objections.

6. New Business

- a. Mr. Meyers shared the board report with council for informational purposes.
- b. Mr. Meyers presented the working high school and middle school schedules. Discussion amongst council regarding staff teaching different classes from the 2021-22 school year.
